



STATE FUNERAL SERVICE FOR UNCLE LYALL MUNRO SENIOR

A NSW State Funeral Service for Uncle Lyall Munro Senior will take place on Saturday, 11 July 2020 in Moree for his immediate family.

The State Funeral for Uncle Lyall will be an important opportunity to honour his extraordinary legacy and contribution to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. Uncle Lyall passed away on 21 May 2020.

In order to continue trying to keep the community safe during COVID-19, the State Funeral Service can only be attended by immediate family members. There will be online options for the community to pay their respects and watch the service at nsw.gov.au/statefuneral

For family attending the funeral, strict health orders will need to be adhered to. This will include providing organisers with your name and contact details in case we need to contact you after the event for health reasons.

Important COVID-19 information for family members attending the funeral

Continue to **#keepourmobsafe**

If you are feeling unwell do not attend the funeral. This will help protect our Elders, vulnerable members of the community and those who already have health problems.

Physical distancing and hygiene measures will be in place at the funeral.

To protect yourself and your community you must continue to:

- Keep a safe physical distance from others (1.5 metres — that's two big steps)
- Wash your hands thoroughly and often. Keep hand sanitiser with you
- Watch out for any symptoms of COVID-19
- **Do not attend and do not travel** if you are unwell
- Go and get tested nearby even if you only have mild symptoms
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue or your elbow — but remember, if you are experiencing symptoms, do not attend
- If you notice a family member or someone else with symptoms, encourage them to go and get tested
- Do not share food utensils, drink utensils or cigarettes
- Consider downloading the COVIDSafe app on your phone.
