

PRIVACY COLLECTION NOTICE

Submissions on review of the *Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983*.

Aboriginal Affairs NSW is committed to protecting your personal information in accordance with the principles of NSW privacy legislation. Aboriginal Affairs NSW is part of the NSW Department of Education (DoE). Personal information is information from which your identity is apparent or can be ascertained. Why is Aboriginal Affairs collecting submissions?

The information in your submission will be collected by Aboriginal Affairs for the purpose of:

- informing the review of the *Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983*.
- preparing briefings to the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs.

What will we do with your submissions?

Aboriginal Affairs may do the following with your submissions:

- publish a copy of your submissions on the Department of Education's Aboriginal Affairs website.
- quote directly from your submission in a review of documentation.
- make your submissions available to other NSW Government agencies.
- make your submission available for publication in the final Statutory Report which will be tabled in NSW Parliament and published on the NSW Parliament website.

Who can access your submissions?

Submissions published on Government department and NSW Parliament websites are accessible worldwide. Published submissions may remain on external servers even after removal from NSW Government websites.

All submissions are public documents and may be accessed under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2003* (GIPA). If you advise that you do not want your personal information disclosed this will be taken into consideration when processing an application made under GIPA.

Can I protect my privacy if I make a submission?

When publishing and disclosing your submission Aboriginal Affairs will include your name, and if you are making a submission as an organisation the name of your organisation may be published.

If you do not want your personal information disclosed or published in connection with your submission please advise this in your written submission by including the statement below:

I do not want my name, address or contact details published or disclosed with my submission. I have not included information that will identify me or others in my submissions or attachments.

By including this statement, you acknowledge that you have not included your personal information in the content of your submissions or its attachments and do not consent to Aboriginal Affairs disclosing or publishing your name, address or other contact details.

Can I access my submissions or other information?
